Miscellaneous:

This will be a state meet qualifier.

Please ¼ inch spikes max and no pin spikes.

We will try to keep heats at 20 competitors max.

Entries:

Fee: \$75.00 for each team, or \$10.00 for each individual runner.

Enter 4 athletes per event and 1 team in each relay.

The Open 5K is a \$3.00 entry (gate) fee per athlete.

Please enter athletes on Athletic.net by April 14th.

Open 5K – “Kristen Yoder 5K Memorial Run” This race is open to the public. (Coaches, parents, etc) Men and women will race together. It should give the high school athletes a small break between the 3200 and 800. The top 4 finishers overall, both men and women, will medal in this race. The race is free to enter however you must pay \$3.00 at the gate.

800 m. run

aprox 7:00 PM OPEN 5K – this race is open to the public.

3200 m. run

4x800 m. relay
