### Entry Fee Information

There will be an entry fee of \$20 per athlete, with a maximum of \$200 per team. Boy's and Girl's teams are considered separate. All entry fees are non-refundable and nontransferable. **All payment must be received prior to the competition or on the day of the competition.** Team packets will not be released if payment is not received. ### Team Entry Information

Each team can submit **THREE** athletes per event!!! Athletes will be seeded into sections based on times listed in a descending order list. The top marks in each event will automatically be entered into the seeded sections of the meet. If an athlete does not make the seeded sections in an event, then they will be placed into the unseeded section in that on Thursday.

- ❖ If an athlete competes in the unseeded section of the meet...they will not be allowed to compete in the seeded sections of the meet.  
**CLARIFICATION:** This is a per event rule...for example, if an athlete gets into the seeded section of the 100m and they are also running the 200m, but they get into the unseeded section of the 200m, then they will run in the seeded section of the 100m and the unseeded section of the 200m.
- ❖ **Running Events** – In lane races, top **NINE** athletes will make it to the finals.
- ❖ **Relays** ~ Make sure if you have an athlete that is competing in the relay only, that you enter them into the meet. They must have a bib number in order to compete in the meet.
- ❖ There will be **NO** additions or substitutions on the day of the meet, only scratches can be made!!
- ❖ A.I.A rules will apply in all cases (i.e. false start, jewelry, uniform, etc). State qualifying information will be handled by meet management.

### Track Check-in Procedure

Clerking for track events will take place on the North East side of the stadium by the athletic training building. Athletes may check in for their track event 1 hour prior to the start of their event. **Athletes must be checked in for their event 15 minutes prior to the start of their event...if they are not checked in 15 minutes prior to the start they will be scratched!!!** Athletes are to report to the staging area 15 minutes before the start of their race, which is located inside the clerking tent. At that time they will be escorted out to the track for their event. If your athletes are competing in a field event at the same time as a running event, make sure to check out with the field event officials before reporting to the start line of the running event.

- ❖ First Call: 40 minutes before start of event
- ❖ Second Call: 30 minutes before start of event
- ❖ Final Call: 20 minutes before start of event
- ❖ Report Time: 15 minutes before start of event

### Field Event Check-in Procedure

Field participants must check-in with the head judge of their event NO LATER THAN 30 minutes prior to the start of their event. If they are not check-in they will be scratched from the event. They may be in the area of their event for warm-ups one hour prior to the competition.

#### Seeded Sections:

- ❖ Athletes in the seeded sections will have (3) attempts and top **NINE** athletes will make it to the final and get (3) more attempts.

#### Unseeded Sections:

- ❖ Athletes in the unseeded sections will get (4) attempts and all attempts will be measured.

## Implement Weigh-ins

Implement weigh-ins are located in the building on the south end of the stadium and must take place during the listed times below. All implements will be impounded at the time of weigh-in. Certified implements will then be transported to the event site. **Only certified implements may be used during official warm-ups and competition.** Meet management will provide a small selection of implements for use by any competitor. If your implement is not certified...it can not be used for warm-ups or competition. **WEIGH-INS WILL CLOSE AT TIMES BELOW!!!**

## Shot Putters

*DO NOT* put the shots on the grass or on the track. Putting the shot in any other area other than the shot impact area will result in disqualification!!

## Personal Stereo Devices

PLEASE BE ADVISED OF THE FOLLOWING PAC-10 REGULATIONS: "THE USE OF PERSONAL STEREO DEVICES (E.G. WALKMANS, PORTABLE CD PLAYERS, HEADSETS, ECT.) AS WELL AS CELL PHONES ARE PROHIBITED IN THE OFFICIAL WARM-UP AND COMPETITIVE AREAS (DESIGNATED BY THE HOST INSTITUTION) FOR BOTH REGULAR SEASON AND THE CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP. THE MEET REFEREE WILL ISSUE A WARNING TO ANYONE USING SUCH A DEVICE. A SECOND VIOLATION OF THE RULE AT THE SAME MEET WOULD RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION FROM THAT MEET." AT OUR FACILITY THAT WILL INCLUDE ANYWHERE WITHIN THE STADIUM FENCES, EXCEPT THE TRAINING TENT, BLEACHERS, AND SPECTATOR AREA ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE STADIUM.

## Coaches

Coaches will **NOT** be allowed on the track and infield. Please instruct athletes, trainers, managers, etc. to stay behind the fence that circles the track when not in competition or attending to an injured athlete. There will be coaches boxes set up for the pole vault only to be utilized during the warm-ups...then coaches will be asked to leave the infield.

## Awards

Willie Williams Classic/USA track Coaches Association medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each event in the seeded sections as well as relays. Awards will be handed out at the end of each final event. Field event awards will be handed out at the event site. **Awards are only given out to the Top 3 finishers in the seeded section of the meet.**

## Bib Numbers/Hip Numbers

All Athletes are to wear their bib numbers on the front of their uniforms, with the exception of the pole vaulters, who can wear it on the back of your uniform. Hip numbers are to be worn on the athletes left hip.

## Trainers

The University of Arizona athletic trainers will set up in the North East area of the stadium. Your trainers may also set up in this area. University of Arizona athletic trainers are prohibited from providing treatment or taping of any High School athletes. First Aid technicians will be onsite to provide and first aid care if it becomes necessary.

## Spikes

Spikes with one-quarter (1/4") or three-eighths (3/8") will be allowed.

## Warm-up Area

Warm-up and cool-downs are to take place outside of the track. The soccer field that is located to the northeast of the stadium will be can be used for warm-ups & cool-downs. There will be hurdles located on the soccer field for hurdle warm-ups.

## Admission

Spectator admission will be \$6.00 for adults, \$4.00 for seniors, and \$3.00 for youth (high school age & under). Spectators are **NOT** allowed on the track at any time. Spectators can purchase tickets ahead of time online at the website at [www.arizonawildcats.com](http://www.arizonawildcats.com). Coaches will have wristbands for admission for all three days of competition...athletes will use their bib numbers for admission into the meet.

## Parking

Parking around the fenced area of Roy P. Drachman stadium is free of charge and open to the public. Parking inside of the stadium and by the soccer field will be closed.
